Biographical/Historical Note

Dr. Morrison started the Canadaway Creek Anthropology Project (CCAP), which brought SUNY Fredonia students and northern Chautauqua County residents together in the study of local historical anthropology. The group focused on the changing partnership of nature and humanity, specifically, the interrelationships of Canadaway Creek with its human communities through time.

Scope and Content

This collection is comprised of research materials gathered by Dr. Morrison for the anthropological study of Canadaway Creek, as well as published reports of the project's findings. The three eras studied; The Native American Epoch, the Era of Water Power, and Pollution-Floods-Controls-Diversions, are reflected in this collection.
